Description:

Netball America® seeks two (2) Directors to oversee Member Programs – an East Coast and a West Coast Member Director. The ideal candidates shall be currently studying for a degree in sports management and/or business or hold a degree in these fields. The candidates need to be reliable and highly energetic persons with strong communication skills and enjoy networking and travelling. There is no need to have experience with Netball.

The positions are flexible and will work around your current study and/or other work schedule. Average hours will be 2-5hrs / week, depending on events, projects and other activities. Given we host and participate in events there may be evenings and weekend times required. In person events may require your time for 2 or more days in a row to be onsite. Remuneration will be \$15 per hour as a consultant fee. A monthly schedule and deliverables will be coordinated with you to work around your other commitments.

Responsibilities:

- Work alongside a Co-Director to help manage the day-to-day programs supporting Netball America's 50+ member Netball clubs across the USA and Canada.
- Understand and get to know our members, their needs and stages of development.
- Learn about the programs and assist in delivering our strategies.
- ➤ Work with the CEO to establish plans, goals and budgets for the programs for the year and monitoring Key Performance Indicators (KPIs).
- Attend various events and conferences to represent Netball America® and possibly oversee volunteers.
- > Launch new initiatives as directed by the Board of Directors.
- ➤ Incorporate current regional Vice Presidents into your committees and establish committee goals, tracking and regular meetings.
- Provide written reports for the quarterly Board of Director Meetings.
- Abide by all timelines and deadlines set.
- Work with other Vice Presidents (such as social media, elite performance etc.) to understand their plans for the region. Communicate regularly with members.
- Speak at various events (in person and remote).
- > Travel to various locations to support Netball America®, members, partners and sponsor events (or identify an appropriate representative from your committee or region to attend).
- Attend any mandatory training or meetings, virtually or in person, set by Netball America®.
- Uphold all policies and protocols set by Netball America®.

- Ability to model and encourage positive behaviors while representing yourself as an ambassador for Netball America®.
